#### Response is based on 2 pillars


- 1. Slowdown the spread

- 21789 poorest households provided ration

- Ration package included cereals, pulses, oil, vegetables and spices



35351 households provided support for kitchen vegetable gardens for securing long term nutrition of poorest households


